

## AIR JUMPER GUIDELINES – PERMIT ADDENDUM as of 3-15-2007

The City of San José has developed the following air jumper guidelines for the purpose of:

- minimizing damage to park turf and irrigation systems from air jumper set-ups;
- minimizing noise intrusion on residential neighborhoods surrounding parks due to this activity; and,
- maximizing the safety and enjoyment for park users.

Applicant is responsible for observing the following guidelines when arranging for an air jumper in a City of San José park:

1. **PERMIT:** Air jumpers are not to be set up in any San José park without a written permit. As of March 15, 2007, there is a \$30 (resident) or \$60 (non-resident) fee for this permit. Permit forms can be obtained from the Parks Reservation office at Leininger Center, 1300 Senter Road, in Kelley Park. Information and/or permit forms can also be obtained by calling (408) 277-2757 and entering ‘21’ when the introductory message begins. ***Submission of the completed form does not guarantee use of the park on the requested date. Also, the Air Jumper Permit does not guarantee a picnic reservation – neighborhood park picnic areas remain first-come first-serve.***

Once the Applicant has completed the permit form, it shall be submitted to Parks Reservation staff in person at Leininger Center in order to obtain the permit. It is the responsibility of the party hiring the air jumper company to obtain this written permit and to inform the selected air jumper vendor with the exact site location for set-up of the air jumper on the event date.

The Applicant shall ensure this permit is posted in a visible location (i.e. on air jumper) during the event.

For air jumper set-ups on a weekend, completed permit forms should be submitted to the Parks Reservation office at Leininger Center one week in advance. If submitted later than this, it is possible an air jumper permit may not be issued.

2. **ALLOWED SITES:** The following parks are the only San José parks where air jumper set-ups are now allowed:

NOTE: Use of a *regional park* requires a picnic reservation in addition to the Air Jumper Permit (fee applies). For more information, contact the Parks Reservation office at (408) 277-2757 and select option “1” from the main menu. Currently, air jumpers are allowed only at Lake Cunningham (a regional park) with a picnic reservation.

3. **VENDOR:** The air jumper rental company must be selected from the City of San José’s list of approved vendors. The listed vendors have met the following minimum requirements:
  - Current insurance policy with \$1 million liability coverage and naming the City of San José as an additional insured
  - Current business tax certificate on file with the City of San José

It is the responsibility of the Applicant to ensure that the vendor selected is on this list and use the vendor listed on the permit on the day of the event.

4. ***TYPE OF JUMPERS ALLOWED:*** *Square inflatables (for jumping only), maximum size 22’W x 22’L x 20’H. Combination features such as a jumper and a slide and/or obstacle course are not allowed; features containing water are not allowed; inflatable sumo wrestling suits are not allowed. Personally owned air jumpers are also not allowed.*
5. **GENERATORS:** Air jumpers should be operated with a diesel generator and preferably a low-noise, park-approved generator. There are no electrical outlets available at parks for public use; therefore arrangements must be made for generator rental through the air jumper vendor. Refueling is not allowed during the rental period (extra fuel for generators is also not allowed). As a courtesy to park neighbors, generators are not to be started prior to 9:00 a.m.

6. AIR JUMPER SET-UP:

The rental company must transport air jumper equipment either by using a cart, hand-truck or similar method of transportation, without driving a motorized vehicle onto park property.

For safety purposes, generators are to be set up 30 feet away from the air jumper.

Block anchors are recommended to weigh down the air jumper. If stakes are used, the Applicant is responsible for any damage to turf and irrigation system.

Placement of jumpers must not infringe on the regular use of the park, and are not to be located on sports fields, within play areas or tot lots, or block access to picnic areas, pathways or play areas.

Air jumpers are not to be placed on concrete or hard surfaces, and must be at least 8 feet away from any object or structure that might hurt an occupant who falls out.

Air jumpers may not be set-up the night prior to an event or left overnight in a park.

7. TIME LIMITS: Air jumpers are not to be set up or generators started prior to 9:00 a.m.; generators are not to be operated after 6:00 p.m. or past sunset, whichever comes first. The permit only allows six (6) consecutive hours of operation of an air jumper.
8. VENDOR RESPONSIBILITY: Vendor shall adhere to items listed above for set-up procedures. Vendor shall provide fire extinguisher with each park rental. Vendor shall have rental equipment removed from park by sunset.
9. DAMAGES: Applicant is responsible for any damage to park property incurred due to air jumper use, including damage to the turf and irrigation system.
10. CANCELLATIONS: Applicant shall notify the Park Reservations office in the event of cancellation. There are no refunds for air jumper fees.
11. PARK RULES AND REGULATIONS: Applicant shall be responsible for adhering to all park rules and regulations as posted at the park and as outlined in the San José Municipal Code Section 13.44.
12. PENALTIES: Violation of park rules and regulations may result in fines (SJMC 13.44).
