GUADALUPE TRAIL USAGE UP CONSIDERABLY

San Jose - The Guadalupe River Park trail appears to be growing in popularity.

San Jose officials are two-thirds of the way through their second annual count of how many people use the trail and the preliminary numbers show a significant increase in trail usage.

City officials have already done two of the three days of counting in Trail Count 2008 and their preliminary numbers show usage on the Guadalupe River Trail is up by almost 70%.

Volunteer trail monitors have also been counting users on the Los Gatos Creek Trail and the Highway 87 bikeway. The final day of Trail Count 2008 is Wednesday.

Officials use the data to help secure grant funding for trail development and maintenance.

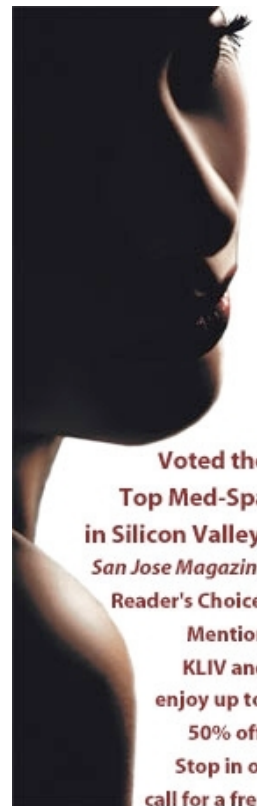
