

ADDENDUM TO AN ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT REPORT

Because minor changes made to the project described below do not raise important new issues about the effects on the environment, this project is adequately covered by this Addendum to the Environmental Impact Report.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION AND LOCATION

PP08-284 *Greenprint 2009 Update for Parks, Recreation Facilities and Trails* is a strategic plan for parks and recreation to the year 2020. The *Greenprint Update* is conceptual in nature and is not intended to show precise locations of improvements.

ANALYSIS:

The project identifies future needs for parks, recreation facilities and trails for the next 11 years and is conceptual in nature. This information will provide background for the development of the City's General Plan update---Envision San Jose 2040.

This is a programmatic environmental review of the *Greenprint Update*, and further environmental review may be required once specific recreational improvements are proposed for construction

The proposed *Greenprint Update* results in the same or less environmental impacts compared to those identified in the General Plan 2020 EIR, and the same mitigation measures, including adhering to the GP policies, will reduce the potential impacts to a less than significant level.

With the identified mitigation measures, the proposed project will not result in significant impact.
